

## Heptathlon Event Trail Descriptions and Maps

### #1 - (July 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>) Periwinkle Creek Trail

Follow a paved path that runs from the northwest corner of Grand Prairie Park to the Albany Boys and Girls Club. **Distance: 3.61 miles**

### #2 - (July 25<sup>th</sup> only) – Historic Home Tour/Scavenger Event

Go to Albany Visitors Association Website the day of event for Tour map and Scavenger Hunt Form, or go to Albany Visitors Association downtown for hard copies any time after 11am on July 25<sup>th</sup>.

### #3 - (Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>) - Cox Creek Loop/ Waverly Lake Loop

From Waverly Parking Lot to the east side of the bridge over Cox Creek, cross Old Salem road and follow the creek to Waverly Street and back. **Distance: 1.35 miles**

### #4 – (Aug 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>) – Oak Creek Greenbelt Trail (off 53<sup>rd</sup> St by Lakeshore Lanes)

A soft surface trail that connects Teloh Calapooia Park with Calapooia River and neighborhoods to the North. **Distance 1.8 miles**

### #5 – (Aug 15th, 16th) - Dave Clark Trail (Trail outline in yellow)

Paved walkway from Bowman Park off Geary St. that ends at Monteith Park. **Distance: 1.5 miles**

### #6 – (Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>) - Tadena Landing Trail

A dirt path running on the north side of the Willamette River that starts at the boat landing and heads to the east until it loops around and takes you back to where you started. **Distance: 1.5 miles each way**

### #7 – (Aug 29<sup>th</sup>) Timber Linn Park

Start from North end of the park & follow paved path to Hwy 20, and then back along Airport side of Price Rd. **Distance: Approx 1.40 mil**
